SUBJ: DEATH OF MGEN ROBERT DUPUIS CMM CD QHP MD CSPQ FRCPC

1. IT IS WITH REGRET THAT I REPORT THE DEATH OF MGEN (RET) J A G R (ROBERT) DUPUIS CMM CD QHP MD CSPQ FRCPC, FORMER SURGEON GENERAL, WHICH OCCURRED IN OTTAWA 28 JANUARY 2019 AT THE AGE OF NINETY YEARS.

MGEN DUPUIS WAS A HIGHLY RESPECTED MEDICAL SPECIALIST WHO DEVOTED OVER FORTY YEARS OF PROFESSIONAL LIFE IN MEDICINE TO THE CANADIAN FORCES, FIRST IN UNIFORM AND LATER AS A CIVILIAN PHYSICIAN.

2. A GRADUATE OF LAVAL UNIVERSITY IN MEDICINE, DR DUPUIS WAS COMMISSIONED A CAPTAIN IN THE ROYAL CANADIAN ARMY MEDICAL CORPS IN 1956 AND POSTED TO THE 3RD BATTALION CANADIAN GUARDS, THE LAST PHYSICIAN TO SERVE AS MEDICAL OFFICER FOR THIS UNIT, WHICH WAS DISBANDED IN 1957. HIS EARLY CAREER AS A MEDICAL OFFICER WAS SPENT IN SUPPORT OF 4 CANADIAN INFANTRY BRIGADE IN GERMANY FROM 1957 TO

1961, INITIALLY AS A PLATOON OFFICER WITH 1 FIELD AMBULANCE STATIONED AT WERL, GERMANY. HE WAS LATER ON STAFF OF THE CANADIAN SECTION OF THE BRITISH MILITARY HOSPITAL IN ISERLOHN, GERMANY.

3. PROMOTED TO MAJOR IN 1961, HE WAS SELECTED FOR POST-GRADUATE TRAINING IN INTERNAL MEDICINE. HIS CLINICAL RESIDENCY WAS CENTRED AT NOTRE DAME HOSPITAL IN MONTREAL AND ALSO INCLUDED TIME AT THE MONTREAL MILITARY HOSPITAL, WHICH WAS ASSOCIATED WITH QUEEN MARY S HOSPITAL FOR VETERANS IN MONTREAL.

4. HIS RESIDENCY PROGRAM WAS INTERRUPTED IN 1963 WHEN HE WAS DEPLOYED TO THE CONGO FOR A SIX MONTH TOUR OF DUTY IN SUPPORT OF THE UNITED NATIONS (UN) MISSION THERE. THIS WAS CANADA S FIRST IMPORTANT PEACEKEEPING MISSION IN AFRICA, CONSISTING OF A BILINGUAL CANADIAN SIGNALS SQUADRON AND LOGISTICS ORGANIZATION, BOTH OF WHICH PROVIDED A BRIDGE BETWEEN BELGIAN AND CONGOLESE FORCES AND OTHER ENGLISH-SPEAKING UN TROOPS. DR DUPUIS RESUMED HIS SPECIALTY TRAINING IN 1964 AND WAS ADMITTED AS A FELLOW OF THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF PHYSICIANS OF CANADA (FRCPC) IN 1965. HE WAS ALSO ADMITTED TO THE COLLEGE DES MÉDECINS SPÉCIALISTES DU QUÉBEC (CSPQ) IN INTERNAL MEDICINE.

5. FROM MONTREAL, MAJ DUPUIS WAS APPOINTED ASSISTANT CHIEF OF

MEDICINE AT CANADIAN FORCES HOSPITAL KINGSTON, WHERE HE PRACTICED UNTIL HE WAS AGAIN DEPLOYED TO AFRICA IN 1967. STATIONED IN ACCRA, GHANA, MAJ DUPUIS SERVED AS THE SPECIALIST IN MEDICINE AT THE UN MILITARY HOSPITAL. THIS DEPLOYMENT WAS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CANADIAN TRAINING ASSISTANCE MISSION TO GHANA WHICH WAS CARRIED OUT FROM 1964 -1973.

6. UPON RETURN FROM GHANA IN 1969, DR DUPUIS WAS PROMOTED TO THE RANK OF LIEUTENANT-COLONEL AND POSTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE AT THE NATIONAL DEFENCE MEDICAL CENTRE (NDMC) WHERE HE HELPED START THE CANADIAN FORCES CENTRE FOR TROPICAL DISEASES. HE WAS PROMOTED TO COLONEL IN 1972 AND APPOINTED CHIEF OF MEDICINE AT NDMC, WHICH POSITION HE HELD UNTIL NOVEMBER 1979. DURING THIS PERIOD COL DUPUIS WAS APPOINTED ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF MEDICINE WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF OTTAWA FACULTY OF MEDICINE, TEACHING CLINICAL MEDICINE TO UNDERGRADUATE AND GRADUATE STUDENTS AT NDMC. IN ADDITION TO HIS CLINICAL AND ACADEMIC DUTIES, COL DUPUIS SERVED A FULL TERM AS CHIEF OF THE MEDICAL STAFF AT NDMC IN 1975.

7. COL DUPUIS WAS FOR MANY YEARS THE PHYSICIAN IN CHARGE OF THE CENTRE FOR TROPICAL DISEASE AT NDMC AND WAS INSTRUMENTAL IN BUILDING

A NATIONAL REPUTATION FOR THIS INSTITUTION. HE SERVED AS THE LEAD AUTHOR OF TRAVELERS TO THE TROPICS : GUIDELINES FOR PHYSICIANS (1978) THE CENTRE WAS ONE OF THE FEW TROPICAL DISEASE UNITS IN THE COUNTRY, POSSESSING HIGHLY SPECIALIZED LABORATORY AND ISOLATION FACILITIES AND CAPABLE OF DELIVERING COMPLEX MEDICAL AND PHARMACOLOGICAL TREATMENTS. THE SURGEON GENERAL AT THAT TIME (MGEN BARR) AUGMENTED THE CANADIAN FORCES ABILITY TO DEAL WITH HIGHLY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES BY OBTAINING PORTABLE TREATMENT UNITS KNOWN AS CONTAINMENT AIRCRAFT TRANSIT ISOLATORS OR CATIS. THESE UNITS WERE USED FOR THE AEROMEDICAL EVACUATION OF PATIENTS WITH KNOWN OR SUSPECTED EXOTIC AND DANGEROUS DISEASES. 8. IN NOV 1979 COL DUPUIS WAS PROMOTED BRIGADIER GENERAL AND ENTRUSTED WITH COMMAND OF NDMC. IN THIS ROLE HIS SKILLS AS AN ADMINISTRATOR CAME TO THE FOREFRONT. MANY EFFORTS WERE MADE TO IMPROVE THE SCOPE AND EFFECTIVENESS OF NDMC BOTH AS A HOSPITAL AND TEACHING CENTRE. IN 1979-1980, DURING A NATIONAL LASSA FEVER SCARE, THE CATIS AND THE CENTRE FOR TROPICAL DISEASE PLAYED AN IMPORTANT PART IN SUPPORTING THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT S CONTAINMENT EFFORTS. THUS DURING BGEN DUPUIS PERIOD IN COMMAND OF NDMC THESE FACILITIES REACHED THEIR PEAK EFFECTIVENESS

AND USE, ENTIRELY IN SUPPORT OF NATIONAL EMERGENCIES.

9. IN 1985 MGEN DUPUIS WAS ADVANCED TO THE RANK OF MAJOR GENERAL AND SUCCEEDED MGEN MCPHERSON AS SURGEON GENERAL. DURING MGEN DUPUIS TENURE THE CANADIAN FORCES MEDICAL SERVICE ENJOYED A STRONG REPUTATION FOR CLINICAL SERVICE AND A HIGH LEVEL OF MORALE. A YEAR LONG SCHEDULE OF SPECIAL CLINICAL CONFERENCES, SKILLS COMPETITIONS, SOCIAL EVENTS, AND CELEBRATIONS TOOK PLACE IN 1984 TO MARK THE SILVER JUBILEE OF THE CFMS.

10. IN 1985 THE CFMS CELEBRATED 100 YEARS OF CANADIAN MILITARY MEDICAL OPERATIONS, WHICH BEGAN WITH THE FORMATION OF FIELD MEDICAL UNITS TO SUPPORT THE NORTH WEST FIELD FORCE IN 1885. MGEN DUPUIS, IN COLLABORATION WITH MGEN BARR, HONORARY COLONEL-COMMANDANT, MADE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE QUEEN MOTHER S VISIT TO THE CFMS AND THE PRESENTATION OF THE QUEEN MOTHER S BANNER. THIS TOOK PLACE DURING A BEAUTIFUL CELEBRATION AT QUEEN S PARK, TORONTO. 11. FOR HIS HOSPITAL WORK, MGEN DUPUIS WAS ADMITTED TO THE VENERABLE ORDER OF ST JOHN OF JERUSALEM AS A SERVING BROTHER IN 1975, ADVANCED

TO AN OFFICER OF THE ORDER IN 1981 AND TO COMMANDER IN 1983. IN RECOGNITION OF HIS MANY CONTRIBUTIONS TO PROFESSIONAL EXCELLENCE IN MILITARY MEDICINE, MGEN DUPUIS WAS APPOINTED A COMMANDER OF THE ORDER OF MILITARY MERIT IN 1984. HE SERVED TWO TERMS AS QUEEN S HONORARY PHYSICIAN (QHP) FROM 1980 UNTIL 1985. IN ADDITION TO HIS MEDALS FOR UN SERVICE IN THE CONGO AND IN GHANA, HE EARNED THE CANADIAN DECORATION WITH TWO ROSETTES FOR 32 YEARS OF LONG AND GOOD SERVICE TO THE CANADIAN FORCES 1956-1985 AND 1994-1997.

12. UPON RETIREMENT AS SURGEON GENERAL, MGEN DUPUIS TOOK UP HIS FORMER ROLE AT NDMC AS A CONSULTING SPECIALIST IN INTERNAL MEDICINE, REMAINING A CORNERSTONE OF THE DEPARTMENT UNTIL THE HOSPITAL CLOSED IN 1995.

13. IN PRIVATE LIFE MGEN DUPUIS CONTINUED HIS ASSOCIATION WITH THE MEDICAL BRANCH, SERVING AS HONORARY COLONEL OF 28 (OTTAWA) MEDICAL COMPANY FROM 1994 UNTIL 1997. THE DEFENCE MEDICAL ASSOCIATION ALSO BENEFITTED FROM HIS ACTIVE INTEREST. HE WAS A WONDERFUL COMPANION AT MEDICAL MESS DINNERS WHERE HE INVARIABLY ENTERTAINED ATTENDEES WITH HIS REMARKABLE PIANO REPERTOIRE. MGEN DUPUIS WAS A GUEST OF HONOR AT THE MEDICAL BRANCH MESS DINNER HELD IN 2009 IN CELEBRATION OF THE

GOLDEN JUBILEE OF THE CFMS. A STEADFAST FRIEND TO THE MEDICAL SERVICE, ONLY RECENTLY HAS FAILING HEALTH PREVENTED HIS PARTICIPATION IN MEDICAL BRANCH EVENTS.

14. THE SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE ROYAL CANADIAN MEDICAL SERVICE AND THE CANADIAN FORCES HEALTH SERVICES GROUP ARE EXTENDED TO HIS WIDOW, CLAIRE, HIS FAMILY AND HIS MANY FRIENDS.

15. A MEMORIAL SERVICE AND FUNERAL MASS WILL TAKE PLACE TUESDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2019 AT L EGLISE ST JOSEPH D ORLÉANS, 2757 ST JOSEPH BLVD, ORLÉANS, ON. THE MEMORIAL SERVICE WILL BE HELD FROM 0900 TO 1045 HOURS. FUNERAL MASS WILL FOLLOW AT 1100. ATTENDEES ARE REQUESTED TO NOTIFY CAPTAIN MARY MCCUTCHEON, ADC, AT MARY.MCCUTCHEONATFORCES.GC.CA. THOSE WISHING TO SPEAK AT THE CLOSE OF THE MEMORIAL MUST SIGNAL THEIR INTENTION TO CAPT MCCUTCHEON FOR INCLUSION IN THE PLAN OF EVENTS.
